Key Stage 3

All Year 7 pupils have one lesson per week following the new Computing curriculum.

All Year 8 pupils have one lesson per fortnight following the new Computing curriculum

Year 9's select ICT/Computing as an option block from this year and it has proven very popular. We have 10 groups doing a variety of 3, 2 or 1 hour per fortnight covering the Computing curriculum and ICT in preparation for GCSE options in Year 10.

Key Stage 4

There are six classes of students in Year 10 & 11 who choose to take ICT as an option – Year 10 & 11 are on BTEC DIT.

There are four Year 10 & 11 classes of OCR GCSE Computer Science 9-1 (reformed 2016).

Post 16

We have three groups in Year 12 – one following the BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in IT, one following the BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in IT. Finally a Level 2 group how who are completing the final year of the BTEC DIT.

Also, there are two Year 13 groups both following the BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in IT and one following BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in IT.

We also have one Year 12 and one Year 13 class undertaking the OCR Computer Science A-Level.

1. Teach Computing at KS3 Year 7, 8 and 9
2. Possible teaching in KS4 or 5 in IT or Computer Science depending upon strengths, timetabling and experience.
