Excellent Environment, Excellent Teaching and Learning

As well as our beautiful, 150 year old building, with its own chapel and private woodland, we are continually redeveloping our site to make sure our facilities match the variety of needs and abilities of our students across all subject areas.

Recently this has included our dedicated Performing Arts centre, state-of-the-art Design and Technology building, as well as two new outdoor classrooms. We are currently in the process of building a 4G pitch, toilet block and medical centre!

As a school with a popular sixth form, it is essential for us to have subjectspecialist teachers who are capable of both inspiring our Year 7s and preparing college students for university and life after education.

Having a Sixth Form means younger children have the opportunity to play music alongside 18 year old students preparing to join the conservatoire, perform in plays with students preparing for the West End, or take part in sports day with our aspiring athletes, a number of whom have gone on to compete professionally.

This creates an inspirational, collaborative environment where students pursue new pathways with passion.


