In the Business Department at Cardinal Newman Catholic School our aims are as follows:

There are opportunities for colleagues to teach GCSE at key stage 4 and BTEC at key stage 5. We have recently moved to GCSE at key stage 4 as we felt this would give our students better outcomes. We follow the AQA specification. At key stage 5 we currently teach BTEC and offer this as both a single and double option. We also offer a fast track option for those students who wish to do single Business in a year. Business is one of the most popular options at key stage 4 and the most popular option in key stage 5.
