



Mathematics Department Information

The successful applicant will join a large, supportive and forward-thinking department consisting of over twenty members of staff. We are looking for someone with excellent teaching and organisation skills to strengthen the department further and play an important role in raising standards across all the Key Stages. 'A' Level teaching will be available for a suitably qualified candidate. The department has designated rooms for mathematics, good access to ICT facilities to enhance our students' learning and an open-plan working area for staff.

All year groups from 7-11 are set by ability with additional intervention offered in small groups. We follow the Edexcel 9-1 scheme of work with our KS4 classes and offer the Number and Measure award for suitable groups.

We are very proud of our examination results which have been extremely good in the last five years with steady improvements in all Key Stages. Our GCSE 9-4 results in last summer were a very pleasing 82.4% the highest in the Local Authority.

At Key Stage 5 we offer Mathematics and Further Mathematics and our results are within the top 25% of the country for Mathematics and top 10% for Further Mathematics. In addition to this we have a successful programme in GCSE resits.
