

Results and Outcomes for Students 2018

We are extremely proud of the outcomes achieved by our students in the following measures:

Progress 8

Progress for all students is at +0.21 for Progress 8 which means our students have achieved on average over a fifth of a grade better at Cardinal Newman than students with the same starting points nationally. This is in the context of the changes in English and Maths and improved standards nationally.

Attainment 8

Our attainment 8 score is 53.67. There is continuous improvement in the numbers of students achieving the Pass grade in English and Maths (old grade C, new grade 4). There has also been sustained improvement for disadvantaged students tackling the new and more challenging GCSE specifications.

Grade 5+ in English and Mathematics

52% of students achieved the threshold of Grade 5+ in English and Mathematics. 77% of students achieved Grade 4+ in English and Mathematics. Progress as well as attainment is on an improving trend in English and Mathematics. Although year on year comparisons cannot be directly drawn due to the new exam specifications, there is an overall improving trend in progress for disadvantaged students in English and Mathematics.

EBacc

The outcomes for students achieving the EBacc continues to be a strength of the school with 44% achieving the EBacc. There is continuous improvement in the outcomes and progress made by SEND, EAL and students who started at Cardinal Newman with low prior attainment.
